Antique weapons may be brought onto Frederick County public school property for use in classroom presentations under the following conditions:

- A. The presenter submits a resume indicating his expertise in the particular area to the principal of the school where the presentation is requested.
- B. The presenter provides an explanation of his presentation and the reasons for the use of the antique weapon(s).
- C. The presenter specifically states the types and number of antique weapons that will be brought to the school.
- D. The presenter obtains prior approval from the principal of the school where the presentation will occur.
- E. If approval has been granted, the presenter's name will go on a list of approved presenters.
- F. Any change in the type or number of weapons will require the presenter to notify the principal for prior approval. Failure to obtain prior approval will result in the presenter being removed from the approved list.
- G. The presenter shall not carry any ammunition of any kind that may or may not be usable with any of the antique firearms.

NOTE: Also cross-reference Maryland law, Article 27 §36A(b)(4).
